NOTICE OF RESTRICTION

It has been reported to the Standing Committee by the ecclesiastical authority of the Episcopal Church in South Carolina that the attached list includes priests and deacons canonically resident in this diocese who have abandoned The Episcopal Church.

By at least a three-fourths vote, the Standing Committee has determined that such abandonment has taken place. The bishop affirms the determination of the Standing Committee and, by means of this document, restricts the exercise of ministry by the named priests and deacons in The Episcopal Church, in accordance with Title IV, Canon 16, Section 3 of the Constitution and Canons of The Episcopal Church.

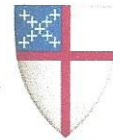
